Dear Parent/Guardian(s),

This letter is to announce and explain I-LEAD Charter School's locker procedure for the 2018-2019 school year. Please be reminded that this procedure applies to all ILCS learners.

I-LEAD Charter School's Locker Policy includes the following procedures and regulations:

- ILCS will **NOT provide locks** for learners during the school year. You may keep only your personal belongings in the locker. Valuable items are discouraged from being brought to school.
- Combination locks will be the only acceptable lock for lockers. Combinations for outside locks must be given to the Head of Security, otherwise the lock will be cut at within 48 hours or at the end of the last school day of the week prior to a weekend or holiday.
- All 9th and 10th grade learners will be required to share a locker with another learner in their grade.
- All 11th and 12th grade learners will have individual lockers.
- Learners are responsible for all contents of the locker, as well as the condition of the locker itself (inside and out). Lockers must be kept free of graffiti or other damage. No permanent marking are allowed in locker, including stickers. The cost of any repairs to damaged or permanently marked lockers will be the responsibility of the learner.
- Learners use the lockers at their own risk. The school is not responsible for any loss of property kept in the locker.
- Learners cannot keep anything illegal in their school locker including, but not limited to:
 - drugs
 - alcohol
 - stolen property
 - weapons

Any learners wishing to have a locker must abide by this Locker Policy. Any learner who fails to abide by this policy will forfeit their right to have a locker.
